As of Q1 2024:

- **131** fixed broadband service providers had launched commercial 5G-based fixed wireless services across 64 markets.
- **22** fixed broadband service providers had announced plans to launch 5G-based fixed wireless services.

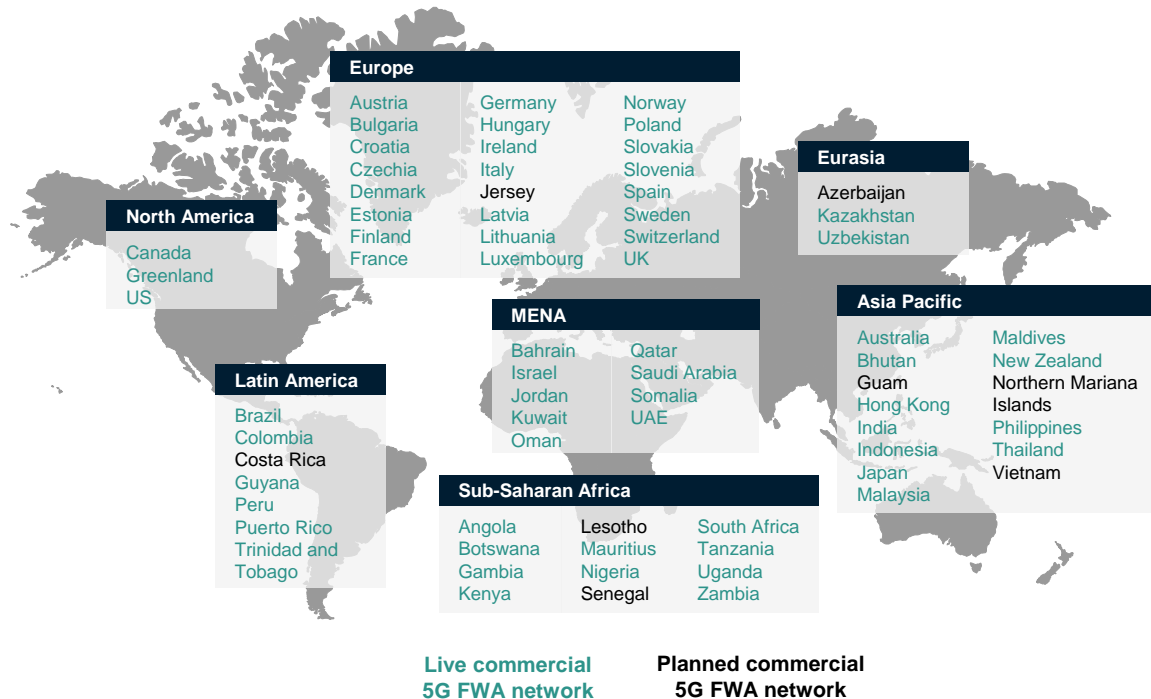

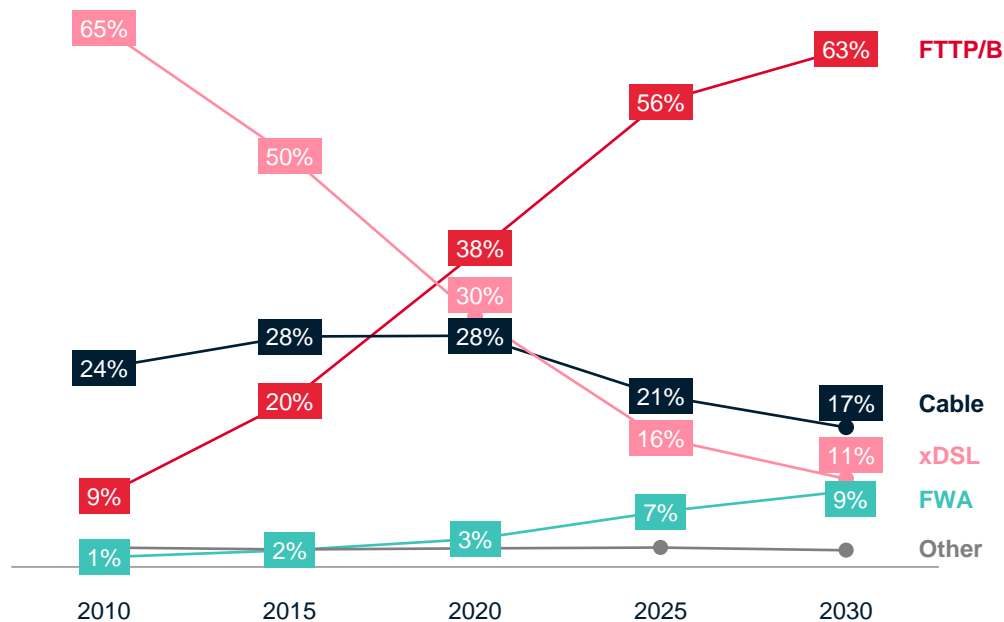

Share of total fixed broadband connections by technology*

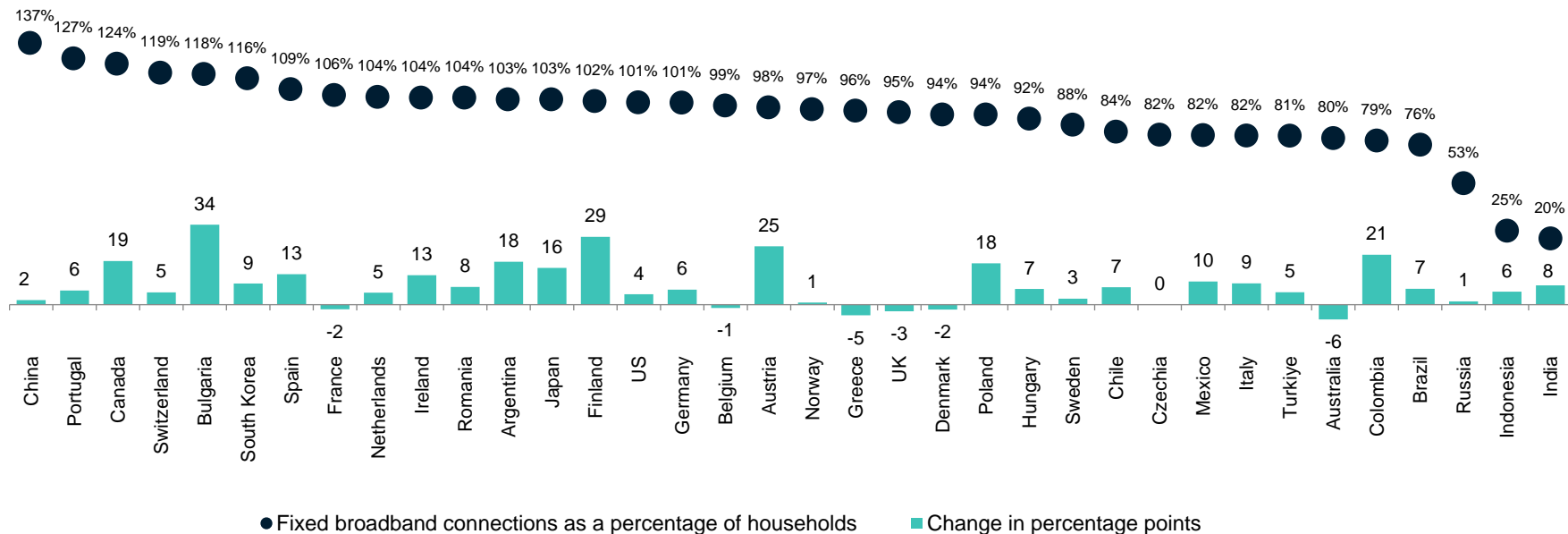

Fixed broadband connections as a percentage of households (end of 2030) and percentage-point change (2023–2030)

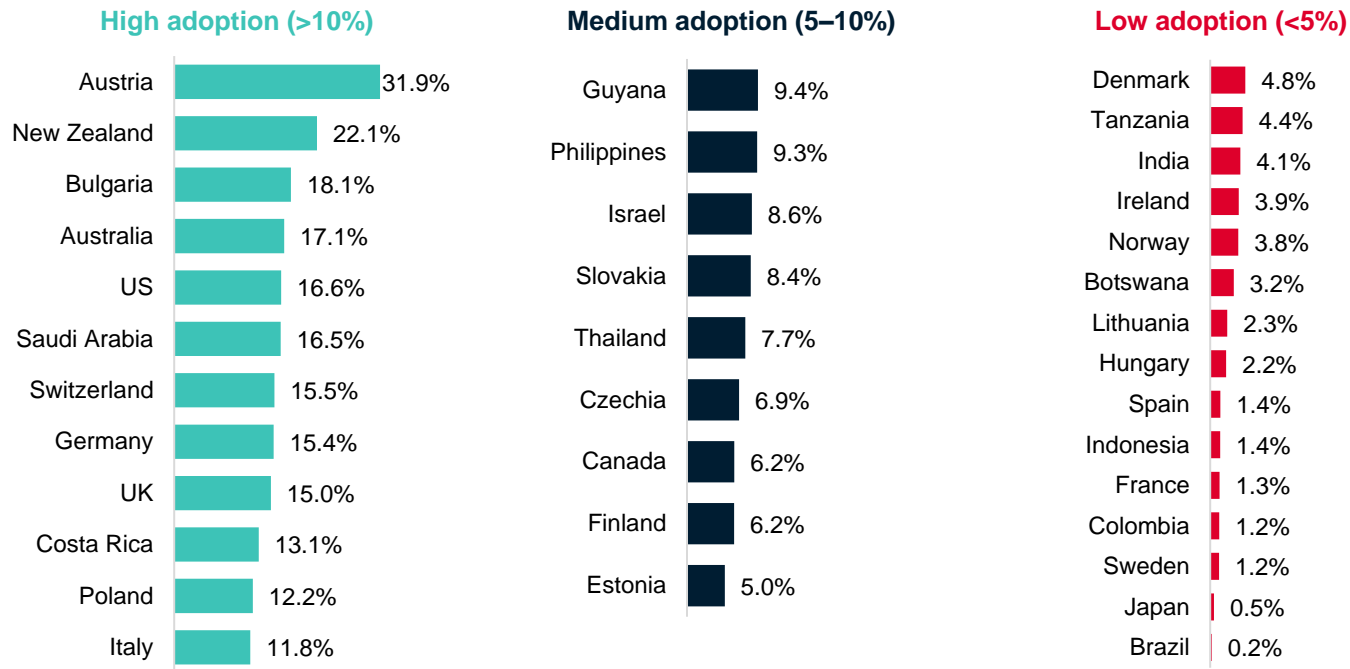
